ROOM RESERVATION PROCEDURES

Colonial Williamsburg Woodlands Hotel & Suites

ANRET Conference Room Rate: \$101.00 US + taxes

All reservations must be accompanied by a one night's deposit for room and tax. Deposits are refundable, provided notice of cancellation is received by Colonial Williamsburg at least 5 days prior to arrival. (Close of business-5:00 pm EST). **Reservations may be charged to Discover, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Diner's Club.** Credit card deposits are charged at the time the reservation is made.

Room rate is daily, single **or** double occupancy. This is a non-commissionable, European-Plan rate and is subject to prevailing taxes, currently 10% and \$2.00 per room per night occupancy tax.

The special conference room rates will apply three (3) days before and (3) days after the dates of the Conference. These rates are subject to the availability of guest rooms.
